

Block Lab Functions Cheatsheet

Basic Helper Functions

```
block_field( $name, $echo = true )
```

Outputs the value of the field. The optional echo is true by default.

```
    block_field( 'field-name' );
```

```
block_value( $name )
```

Returns the value of the field. Essentially the same as `block_field($name, false)`.

```
    block_value( 'field-name' );
```

Config Functions

```
block_config()
```

Returns the block's settings.

```
    block_config();
```

```
block_field_config( $name )
```

Returns the field's settings.

```
    block_field_config( 'field-name' );
```

Repeater Functions

```
block_row()  
block_rows()  
block_sub_field()  
block_sub_value()  
reset_block_rows()
```

These two examples do the same thing. The first uses the `block_sub_field()` function while the second echos the `block_sub_value()` function.

```
while ( block_rows( 'example-repeater-field' ) ) :  
    block_row( 'example-repeater-field' );  
    block_sub_field( 'example-repeater-subfield' );  
endwhile;  
reset_block_rows( 'example-repeater-field' );
```

```
while ( block_rows( 'example-repeater-field' ) ) :  
    block_row( 'example-repeater-field' );  
    echo block_sub_value( 'example-repeater-subfield' );  
endwhile;  
reset_block_rows( 'example-repeater-field' );
```

PHP API Functions

```
block_lab_add_block()  
block_lab_add_field()
```

```
block_lab_add_block( 'example-block', array( 'icon' => 'waves' ) );  
block_lab_add_field( 'example-field-one', 'my-first-example-field' );  
block_lab_add_field( 'example-field-two', 'my-second-example-field', array( 'placeholder' => 'Type something here!' ) );
```
